

# DANCE FOR ALL PROFESSIONAL DANCE TRAINING

## COURSE FEES & FUNDING 2020 - 2021

### AVAILABLE POTENTIAL FUNDING

SQA (HNC & HND) elements, providing *Scottish and EU* students satisfy SAAS eligibility criteria.

#### 1ST YEAR AT DFA

Students apply to the Student Awards Agency Scotland (SAAS).\*

Providing students meet their eligibility criteria, SAAS will provide funding:

- Payment of HNC/HND Tuition Fees (not a loan): £1285 Award
- Student Loan: up to £4,750
- Bursary: up to £2,000 (for low-income families)

*Please note: the Core Private Vocational Training Fees of £4500 will still be due from ALL students.*

#### 2ND YEAR AT DFA

Students apply to the Student Awards Agency Scotland (SAAS).\*

Providing students meet their eligibility criteria, SAAS will provide funding:

- Payment of HNC/HND Tuition Fees (not a loan): £1285 Award
- Student Loan: up to £4,750
- Bursary: up to £2,000 (for low-income families)

*Please note: the Core Private Vocational Training Fees of £4500 will still be due from ALL students.*

### DFA PRIVATE TUITION FEES

Core Private Vocational Training Fees Payable to Dance For All from ALL students

#### 1ST YEAR AT DFA

Core private vocational training fees due from ALL students: £4500 (inc. VAT) Paid to Dance For All in yearly, termly or monthly instalments

Additional costs:

- Replacement dancewear, dance shoes, uniform and make-up, as above
- Costume hire - *show costumes provided by DFA*
- RAD, ISTD & SDS examination fees where applicable
- ISTD teacher training fees: DDI & DDE

#### 2ND YEAR AT DFA

Core private vocational training fees due from ALL students: £4500 (inc. VAT) Paid to Dance For All in yearly, termly or monthly instalments

Additional costs:

- Replacement dancewear, dance shoes, uniform and make-up, as above
- Costume hire - *show costumes provided by DFA*
- RAD, ISTD & SDS examination fees where applicable
- ISTD teacher training fees: DDI & DDE

Dance For All's supplementary private tuition fees are kept to an absolute minimum and reflect the high calibre of teaching and training available.

\*Funding for the SQA (HNC & HND) elements of the course is available to eligible Scottish and EU students. You can apply to Edinburgh College for funding in 1st year and to SAAS for a bursary &/or student loan in 2nd and 3rd year. Students NOT eligible for bursary support or student loan: DFA's private tuition and SQA course fees will be due in full.
